Prior to joining Swiss Re, Philip Walker established a long track record in delivering financial products and services through electronic channels. From 2012 to 2015 he served as Managing Director at Paradigm Partners in California, an M&A and strategic consulting firm for insurers, insurance distributors and private equity companies.

He began his career with Thomas Cook Group as a foreign exchange dealer in Toronto before taking over managerial roles as a Regional Development Manager and Director of Strategy.
