Mathis Cabiallavetta was a member of the Board of Directors of Swiss Re from 18 April 2008 to 22 April 2016. He was Vice Chairman from March 2009 to April 2015.

Mathis Cabiallavetta held several positions at UBS AG from 1971, including President of the Group Executive Board in 1996 and Chairman in 1998. He joined Marsh & McLennan Companies in 1999 and was Vice Chairman of the company from 2001 to 2004. He is a former member of the Bank Council of the Swiss National Bank and a former Vice Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Swiss Bankers Association. He was also a member of the Committee of the Board of Directors of the Swiss Stock Exchange and the International Capital Markets Advisory Committee of the Federal Reserve Bank of New York. Mathis Cabiallavetta is a member of the Board of Directors of BlackRock, Inc. and an Executive Advisory Board member of General Atlantic Partners.

Mathis Cabiallavetta is a Swiss citizen born in 1945. He graduated with a Bachelor's degree in economics from the University of Montreal, Canada.
